Traffic Highlights:

Traffic: Please support your local businesses along 2100 South during construction. Expect delays and consider adding a few minutes to your travel time to avoid feeling rushed. Traffic and parking are no longer permitted within the Plaza Area.

Parking: All parking areas on the south side of 2100 South in the Sugar House Monument Plaza will be closed. *Please do not park in this area.* Please have customers park behind your businesses. **Detours:** Will be posted.

Work in Progress:

Weather permitting This week we will be continuing the concrete work just north of the Paseo, continuing to plant trees and plants, continuing paver work, and continuing electrical work.

Also, please note the southbound lane on Highland Drive has been reopened, and will only be closed on temporary occasions to receive deliveries. Therefore, there is no parking along Highland Drive except in designated areas.

Special Notices:

During the course of construction it is necessary to use heavy equipment. This process can cause things in a building or house to shake and rattle. We suggest that everyone take time make sure items are secured to walls or shelves to prevent them from “shaking” off and breaking. Allstate Construction will not be held responsible for any items damaged during construction.
