VISION

In 2018, Japantown representatives participated in a facilitation process with area stakeholders and produced a list of street improvements and place making ideas they'd like to see come to life for Japantown Street (100 South between 200 West and 300 West).

As a result, the RDA commissioned a design consultant to work with the Japantown community to further articulate their vision and create a Japantown Design Strategy in collaboration with area property owners.

At the end of the process in 2021, the Japantown Design Strategy is intended to:

- Provide a balance of the community's range of priorities;
- Create a vision including street improvements, place making, and Japantown festival setup preferences;
- Integrate the vision with City code requirements and existing uses of the street for feasibility;
- Serve as an important tool for the community to begin seeking funding for the improvements they would like to see.


