## VISION

This redevelopment project will bring new activity and transportation resources to the Granary neighborhood. Its two-story, multi-use building will house a retail space, a community bicycle repair shop for the public, a professional bicycle repair workspace for mechanics, classrooms, administration work space, and a storage area for donated bicycles.

By relocating to the heart of the Granary District, the Collective will bring new shoppers, users, visitors, employees, and volunteers to the neighborhood on a daily basis. Its mission also aligns with the sustainable transportation goals of the development of the 9 Line Trail Corridor, which runs east and west along 900 South.
